

Facelift (Lower Face And Neck Lift) Post-operative Instructions

Instructions: Begin Day of Surgery

- 1. Limit activity to bed rest with bathroom privileges the day of surgery.
- 2. No turning head for one week. If necessary to turn, do so by turning shoulders or body from side to side.
- 3. Apply ice compresses for 24-48 hours. Keep ice on as much as you can tolerate.
- 4. Drink plenty of fluids and avoid foods that require a lot of chewing, as this may increase swelling and prolong healing. Soft regular diet as tolerated. Alcohol should be avoided for **1 week** after surgery.
- 5. Sleep with your head elevated at least 30 degrees (2-3pillows) for 2 weeks.
- 6. Leave dressing in place. Do not remove. Dressing may be reinforced with gauze if needed.
- 7. Call the office if you experience heavy bleeding, (saturating dressing) or experience severe pain.

NOTE: Swelling usually peaks 2-3 days after surgery.

Days 2-7:

- Activity level:
 - o You should be up and walking around the house after 24 hours.
 - o No exercising, or activity that will increase your heart rate or blood pressure, no bending over or lifting over **5 lbs for 2 weeks**.
 - o Do not return to exercise until approved by your physician.
- You will be seen in our office the day after surgery. At that time we will remove the dressing and review wound care instructions with you. You will begin using a facial compression garment (JawBra).
- JawBra must be worn at all times unless showering/bathing or performing suture line care for the first week. JawBraw should feel snug. Make sure seam faces outwards when worn. Wearing the JawBra too loosely or not at all, may result in complications.
- You may shower and shampoo your hair after 24 hours. Do not blow dry your hair. We do not want any heat on or near your face because of the risk of burns.

Begin suture line care Day 2 in the evening: Clean suture lines with normal saline/hydrogen peroxide solution (provided), using gauze pads to remove old ointment. Then spray incisions with Avene spring water (provided), to rinse suture lines. Pat dry with a gauze pad. Apply a thin layer of bacitracin ointment, repeat procedure 2-3 times/day for **3 days.**

On Day 4 continue suture line care but use Vaseline or Aquaphor ointment in place of bacitracin ointment until all sutures (stitches) have been removed.

Continue to sleep on your back with your head elevated at least 30 degrees (2-3 pillows) for two weeks after surgery. This helps reduce bruising, swelling and discomfort. Wear JawBra throughout the 1st week then at night for weeks 2-6.

You may resume wearing makeup on the 9th postoperative day. Hair coloring is usually allowed 2 weeks postoperatively, but please check with your physician first.

*It is common for patients to feel depressed the first few days after surgery. This improves quickly as you begin to look and feel better. There is certainly a "let down period" after the anxiety and excitement of surgery. It will improve as the healing progresses.

Call the office at (410) 486-3400 if you experience: increased pain, swelling, redness at surgical sites, pus draining from wound, or fever above 101.5F.
