

## Nasal Surgery Post-operative Instructions

**Instructions**: Begin Day of Surgery

- 1. Limit activity to bed rest with bathroom privileges the day of surgery.
- 2. Apply ice compresses for 24-48 hours. Keep ice on as much as you can tolerate.
- 3. Sleep with head elevated at least 30 degrees (2-3 pillows) for **1 week.** This helps to decrease swelling, bruising and discomfort.
- 4. Regular diet as tolerated. Alcohol should be avoided for 1 week after surgery.
- 5. NOTE: Swelling usually peaks 2-3 days after surgery.
- 6. Keep splint and tape on top of nose dry.
- 7. Change drip pad as needed. Expect nose to drip and ooze blood for several days. If bleeding persists, please notify your Physician.
- 8. **No nose blowing**. You may sniff back to clear nose after spraying saline solution. Sneeze with your mouth open.
- 9. Nasal saline spray: 2 sprays to each nostril a minimum of every 2 hours while awake. \*You may use it more frequently if needed or desired. \*The more you keep your nose moist, the less you will experience crusting inside your nose. Crusting contributes to post-operative discomfort and nasal obstruction. If your nose becomes completely blocked use a cool mist humidifier.
- 10. Clean inside nostril edges with a Q-tip moistened with sodium chloride and peroxide solution to remove any dried blood, then apply bacitracin ointment. **Do not put Q-tip up nose deeper than the white cotton part of the Q-tip.**

## Days 2-7:

- Activity level:
  - You should be up and walking around the house after 24 hours.
  - No exercising, or activity that will increase your heart rate or blood pressure, no bending over or lifting over 5 lbs for 1 week.
  - Do not return to exercise until approved by your physician.
- If you have a suture line on your nose or ear: <u>Beginning Day 2</u> clean suture lines with the 0.9% sodium chloride, hydrogen peroxide 50/50 solution given using Q-tips, then apply Bacitracin ointment. Repeat 2-3 times a day until your next office visit. Suture lines do not need to be covered by a dressing.
- You must keep your nose, splint, and tape dry until your post-op visit.
   You may shower the next day. Do not get your face wet. Place a towel over your face and tilt head back to wash hair.
- Post-op Visit: Tapes, splints, and any sutures will be removed at the office during your postoperative
  visit.

Call the office at (410) 486-3400 if you experience: increased pain, swelling, redness at surgical sites, pus draining from wound, fever above 101.5F or excessive bleeding.
