

AFTER CARE – FRACTIONATED/ MATRIX / CO2 LASER

DAY OF PROCEDURE (Day 1)

- Keep laser wound area **moist**. Keep covered with EltaMD Laser Balm.
- Spray Avene Thermal Spring Water as many times as you need to keep wound cool.
- Wound may "weep". Blot "weep" off with dry gauze & apply Elta Laser Balm.

DAY AFTER LASER (Day 2)

- Prior to appointment, you may remove Elta Laser Balm and apply a fresh coat or wait until you are seen by the Medical Aesthetician.
- To remove Laser Balm: Soak gauze in the vinegar and water mixture.
- Apply wet gauze to wound blot off or "lightly" wipe off the Laser Balm.

MIX: 1 TEASPOON OR LESS OF WHITE DISTILLED VINEGAR MIXED INTO 2 CUPS OF DISTILLED WATER.

- Spray face with Avene Thermal Water Spray. Press Water into skin. Blot off the excess/dripping water.
- Apply a fresh coat of Laser Balm over the moistened wound.
- When you return home, <u>repeat cleansing 4 times a day AND apply Neova CU3 Tissue Repair Cream to keep wound clean</u>, moist and protected.
- YOU MAY MIST WITH AVENE THERMAL SPRING WATER AS MANY TIMES AS NEEDED.
- NOTE: Day hours use the Neova CU3. Night hours, use the Laser Balm. Laser Balm does not need to be re-applied through the night.
- At appointments with Medical Aesthetician, you will receive the supplies as needed.

WEEK OF LASER (Starting Day 3 until day 7)

- Cleanse face with Hymed Gentle Cleanser. Rinse off cleanser with tap water.
- Soak gauze into the vinegar and water mixture. Blot and lightly wipe off some of the sloughing skin. Repeat this action several times. Pat dry with gauze.
- Spray on Avene Thermal Water and press water into skin to moisten wound.
- Apply a light coat of CU3 Tissue Repair to seal & heal the moistened wound.
- <u>Use Cleanser 2 times a day...REPEAT Avene Thermal Spring Water & CU3 as many times as needed</u> throughout the day.
